Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking setting aside the order dated 07.05.2019, Annexure P-6, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal in FIR No. 816 dated 29.12.2016, registered for offences under Sections 120-B, 302 and 328 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short “IPC”), however, later on Sections 302 and 328, IPC were deleted and Section 306, IPC was added, at Police Station Assandh, Karnal.
