The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on the account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 14.10.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 0042 dated 09.02.2021. Initially the FIR was registered for the offences under Sections 323/324/148/149 IPC and the petitioner was granted bail after his arrest. Thereafter, offence under Section 326 IPC was added. The alleged injury attributed to the petitioner is a spade blow on the ring finger of the left hand of the complainant. In the FIR itself, the said injury is found to be doubtful by the Investigating Officer for want of any traces/ injuries on the adjoining fingers.

Notice of motion for 20.01.2022.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 20.10.2021 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion in the merits of the case. The case shall be decided on the merits on the adjourned date.”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions received from A.S.I. Paramjit Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, co-operated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the order dated 14.10.2021 is hereby made absolute.
