The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking for issuance of a Writ of Certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) whereby the petitioners were proceeded ex-parte and further for quashing the impugned order dated 02.12.2011 (Annexure P-5) passed by the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Gurugram-respondent No.1 in consumer complaint No.145 of 2021 dated 19.02.2021, with a further prayer to stay the operation of the impugned order dated 02.12.2021 (Annexure P-5).
