1. The petitioner, by filing the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 347 of 16.09.2021, which was registered against him, at Police Station Sadar Safidon, District Jind. Therein offences under Sections 420 of the IPC, 1860, and, Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act of 1914 (as Amended by Haryana Amendment Act 2020), are embodied.

2. This Court, through an order made on 14.10.2021, had granted ad interim bail to the bail applicant / petitioner.

3. Learned State Counsel, on instructions, meted to him, by ASI Dilbag Singh, submits that the bail applicant –petitioner, has participated in the relevant investigations, and, he is rendering his fullest co-operation to the IO concerned, and, that no recovery is to be effected. He further submits that petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

4. Consequently, this Court deems it fit and appropriate, to make absolute the order, made by this Court on 14.10.2021. However, the making of absolute of the afore order, shall be subject to the abiding by the bail applicant, of the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. The Investigating Officer concerned, is directed to forthwith ensure the furnishing before him, by the bail applicant, of personal and surety bonds, in a sum of Rs. 50,000/- each. It is also subject to his furnishing an undertaking that as, and, when he is required in the relevant investigations, he shall ensure his making his presence before the IO concerned.
