Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing orders dated 28.01.2019 (Annexure P-8) and 08.07.2019 (Annexue P-10), passed by respondent no.2 and for directing the respondents to grant approval for appointment of the petitioners as JBT Teachers made by the Management/Interview Committee of respondent no.4, and to allow them to work as such as they are fully qualified and eligible for the post of JBT Teacher.

The petitioners are admittedly employees of respondent no.4, which is a Government aided private school.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioners have an alternate efficacious remedy before the Education Tribunal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is unable to deny the same.

Accordingly, petitioners are relegated to their remedy before the Education Tribunal. As interim order staying the operations of orders dated 28.01.2019 (Annexure P-8) and 08.07.2019 (Annexure P-10) was passed on 22.08.2019, it is directed that in case, petitioners approach the Education Tribunal within three weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order, interim order shall enure till then. Needless to say thereafter the matters, including that of interim relief shall be in the realm of consideration of the Education Tribunal.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
