HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that five marks for which the petitioner is entitled for under the no Government job category as no one from the family of the petitioner is in a Government job, has not been extended to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had applied in more than one category and surprisingly, while considering the claim of the petitioner in category No.22 as stated in advertisement No.12 of 2019, the petitioner has been granted the five additional marks but while considering him under the same advertisement in category No.12, the same benefit has not been extended to the petitioner, which is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by filing a representation dated 26.08.2022 (Annexure P-10), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 26.08.2022 (Annexure P-10) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 26.08.2022 (Annexure P-10), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the representation dated 26.08.2022 (Annexure P-10) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
