Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.130 dated 03.10.2020 registered under Sections 323, 354, 354-A, 451, 509 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Women Police Station Sirsa, on the basis of panchayati compromise (Annexure P-1).

Although report has been received from the Trial Court pursuant to order dated 01.12.2020 passed by this Court, but State counsel by placing reliance upon the statement of the prosecutrix recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C has submitted that minor prosecutrix has not only given the details of three incidents mentioned in the FIR, but she has also stated that the petitioner, who lives in neighbourhood has been troubling her for

the last 2-3 years.

Keeping in view the above facts, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition, which is dismissed.
