Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.108 dated 17.08.2022 registered under Sections 452, 294, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, at the instance of the complainant with whom the petitioner is having money dispute. It is further contended that this is a no injury case and the petitioner who is having no criminal history has joined the investigation with the police in pursuance to the previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

The present petition is resisted by the counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant who submits that the petitioner accompanied by some other persons trespassed into shop of the complainant and then threatened to kill him but due to intervention of the neighboring shopkeepers, the complaint was

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Sikarder Singh has admitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and he is not required by the police for further investigation. The State counsel not disputed the fact that the present case is a no injury case.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 05.09.2022 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
