The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0587 dated 04.06.2019 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 IPC (Section 324 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal on the basis of a written compromise Annexure P-2 entered into between the parties.

On 14.10.2021 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the genuineness of the compromise between the parties as also to intimate this Court whether any P.O. proceedings are pending against any of the party.

As directed, report dated 16.12.2021 from the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal has been received as per which the parties had recorded their statements before the Trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them; the same is genuine and that no P.O. proceedings are pending against any of the party.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR which arises from a matrimonial dispute as also the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in *Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab* (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No.0587 dated 04.06.2019 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 IPC (Section 324 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.
