This is second petition of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.15 dated 10.04.2020 under Sections 363, 366A, 376(D)(a), 376(3), 354-D, 506 and 34 IPC and Sections 4 and 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Women Hansi, District Hisar.

At the outset, on a query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to what were the material change in the circumstances subsequent to the dismissal of the previous petition of the petitioner seeking similar relief to which he submitted that the victim stood examined.

This Court, in the circumstances, would not be inclined to entertain the instant petition as the previous petition of the petitioner

was dismissed after hearing learned counsel for the petitioner at length and on merits. Still further, learned counsel has been unable to bring to the notice of this Court any material change in circumstances which would warrant entertaining the instant petition. Resultantly, the instant petition being devoid of any merit, stands dismissed.
