Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.10 dated 7.2.2021 registered under Section 304-B IPC, at Police Station Dorangala, District Gurdaspur.
