ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed for issuing directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (P-1) and to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the hands of private respondents.

Notice served upon the official respondents through State's counsel. No notices are required to issue to the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case direction be issued to respondent No.2, to decide the representation dated 25.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.2- Director General of Police Punjab, Civil Secretariat, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) either himself or by authorizing any officer not below the rank of IPS cadre, by passing a speaking and reasoned order ***within 30 working days from today.***

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.

The concerned authorities to communicate the order to the representationist without any delay.
