Reply on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record.

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is qua the transfer order dated 28.08.2022 (Annexure P-18).

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has been transferred from the present place of posting and the net result is that no teacher is available to teach the subject which the petitioner was teaching at the present place of posting and further grievance is that there are stations near the place of present posting of the petitioner, where the petitioner can be easily adjusted, but the claim of the petitioner is not being considered qua the said stations.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to submit before this Court that in case the petitioner raises her grievance as has been raised in the present petition, by way of filing an appropriate representation upto 19.09.2022, the same shall be decided in accordance with law coupled with the provisions of transfer policy and an appropriate decision will be taken on the same within a period of 10 days from the receipt of any such

representation. In case, the petitioner has not been relieved till today from the present place of posting then she will be allowed to continue at the present place of posting till the decision of the said representation, if the same is filed by the petitioner and in case, the petitioner has already been relieved from the present place of posting, she will not be forced to join at the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents by way of representation.

Ordered accordingly.
