ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel submits that in FIR No.176 dated 19.07.2021, charges have already been framed rendering the present petition infructuous. Regarding other FIRs, learned counsel for the State submits that the investigation is in progress.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is also aggrieved because of sloth paced investigation in other FIRs and he seeks liberty to file a separate petition for both the FIRs seeking investigation or its transfer to any other investigation agencies.

Prayer being innocuous is accepted.

Given above, the petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for. It is further clarified that it shall be permissible for the petitioner to file an application under Section 319 CrPC in FIR No.176 and also to avail separate legal remedies in the same.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
