Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.104 dated 01.08.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A & 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Vide order dated 04.02.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 04.02.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He further submits that the parties have also settled the dispute amicably and in pursuance to the compromise arrived at between the parties, the marriage has been dissolved by decree of divorce filed under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 04.02.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
