This writ petition was filed in the year 2017 seeking appointment as a Male Constable (General Duty) pursuant to having applied under advertisement No.8/2015. When the matter was initially heard, counsel for the petitioner had contended that the petitioner had got 54.60 marks and as selected candidates had not joined, he should be called upon to do so. He had placed reliance upon CWP No.21051 of 2017, titled as *Devender and others Versus State of Haryana and others*. The matter was adjourned on subsequent dates and was taken up for hearing on 05.02.2020, on which date, counsel for the petitioner did not put in appearance. State counsel informed the court that the writ petition as relied upon by the counsel for the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a composite writ petition. Counsel for the petitioner was given a direction to examine the matter and make submissions on the next date of hearing. The

matter was again listed on 31.03.2022. When there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioner, this Court directed that the matter be taken up and listed for hearing in the urgent list.

Today, the matter was called twice, however, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Consequently, the present writ petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
