1. This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 16, dated 28th July, 2022, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 18620 and Sections 13(1) (A) and 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (for short 'the Act'), registered at Police Station SVB, Ambala.

2. This Court vide order dated 5th September, 2022, stayed the arrest of the petitioner, subject to joining investigation.

3. Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Inspector Suresh Kumar submits that the petitioner joined the investigation and is co-operating.

4. As the petitioner has joined the investigation and lending co-operation, the interim order dated 5th September, 2022 is made absolute.

5. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He is directed to join the investigation as and when called for. He shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. The petition is allowed.

7. In case of failure of petitioner to join the investigation, the State would be at liberty to file an application for re-calling of this order.
8. Since the main case has been decided, the pending applications, if any, is rendered infructuous.
