The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.82 dated 27.06.2022 under Sections 365, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned counsel for the State has filed status report dated 15.12.2022 in the Court today. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Bikker Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 02.09.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 02.09.2022 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
