Present petition has been filed praying for issuance of directions to respondent no.2 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a false and frivolous complaint has been filed by respondent no.5 i.e. mother-in-law of the petitioner against the petitioner. He submits that on the basis of the same police has issued summons under section 160 Cr.P.C against the petitioner and she is being unnecessarily harassed by the police by calling her to the police station. Counsel submits that in view of the mandate of section 160 Cr.P.C a woman cannot be called to the police station and she has to be questioned at her place of residence only.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

Learned State counsel submits that on the basis of the complaint filed against the petitioner, an inquiry is being conducted for which impugned summons have been issued. He submits that police would depute a lady officer to proceed with the inquiry and she would go to the

residence of the petitioner for further inquiry. He submits that the inquiry would be conducted strictly in accordance with law.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, present petition is disposed of in the above terms.
