Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for quashing the regularization of respondent No.6 as he did not complete the requisite 10 years' continue service as per the regularization Policy dated 18.03.2011 (P-1).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 23.06.2022 (P-9) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 23.06.2022 (P-9) by passing reasoned order as per law within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
