Learned counsel for the respondents has produced the OMR sheet of the petitioner, according to which, the petitioner has secured only 50 marks out of total 80 marks and has not been able to secure the marks required to be called for interview. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that keeping in view the said marks, the petitioner is not within the zone of selection for the reason that the last selected candidate in the category in which the petitioner is competing, has secured 125 marks and even if, the petitioner is given full marks in the interview still the petitioner will fall short of the marks secured by the last selected candidate.
