As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.31,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that the enhanced amount be paid to all the appellants in the ratio as apportioned by the learned MACT i.e. 10% to claimant No.6 and 18% each to claimants 1 to 5 and since claimant No.5 has died, his share be paid to claimant No.1-Parli Devi, being mother of claimant No.5, in full & final satisfaction of the claim. Learned counsel for the Insurance Company has also filed the statement of Ms. Divya Kotru, Manager, Future General Insurance Company offering a sum of Rs.31,00,000/- to the claimants, which is taken on record.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit five cheques; one in the sum of Rs.11,16,000/- favouring appellant No.1, three cheques in the sum of Rs.5,58,000/- each favouring appellants 2 to 4 and one cheque in the sum of Rs.3,10,000/- favouring appellant No.6 with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 16.09.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
