Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.159 dated 05.08.2022 registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 01.09.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 01.09.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malkeet Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
