The petitioner's application to delete his name from the array of defendants has been dismissed by the trial court on 02.05.2019. The plaintiff's suit for recovery of Rs.13,23,000/- along with the interest against M/s Raj Trading Company is pending. The firm was sued through the petitioner. Subsequently, on an application filed, the firm was sued through Smt. Darshana Rani, the petitioner's wife. However, the plaintiff while filing the written statement impleaded the petitioner as defendant no.2.

The petitioner claims that he has no role to play in the firm M/s Raj Trading Company. Hence, his name should be deleted from the array of parties. The plaintiff opposes the prayer made by the defendant.

Keeping in view the close relationship between defendant no.1 and 2, at this stage, it would not be appropriate for the Court to delete the name of the petitioner from the array of parties.

Hence, no ground to interfere with the order passed by the trial court is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
