Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case, FIR No. 84 dated 22.03.2021 registered under Section 17 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

At the very outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner would refer to order dated 13.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed in CRM-M-31552-2021 whereby co-accused of the petitioner have been granted interim bail in view of the fact that the FSL report in the case not been received so far and in view of observations in Para No. 54 of judgment passed by a Division Bench of this Court in case '**Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and Others Vs. State of Punjab : 2014 (3) RCR (Criminal)**

953.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner seeks parity with co-accused of the petitioner and restricted his prayer made in the petition to grant of interim bail to the petitioner till receipt of FSL Report.

Learned State Counsel has conceded that FSL report in the case has not been received so far.

In view of the fact that the FSL report in the case has not been received so far and observations of this Court in Para No.54 of the judgment passed in *Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and others Vs. State of Punjab : 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 953* favouring release on interim bail till receipt of FSL report but without commenting on merits of the case, I am of the considered view that the petitioner deserves the concession of interim regular bail till receipt of FSL report.

Therefore, the petition is disposed of and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim regular bail till receipt of FSL report on furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

On receipt of FSL report, the petitioner shall apply for regular bail before the trial Court which shall be at liberty to decide the same in accordance with law keeping in view the FSL report.
