The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
For quashing of FIR No. 99 dated 24.03.2018 under Sections 406, 420 and
120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station
Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some
time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with
liberty to take up all the points which have been raised in the present
petition and are available to the petitioner during the course of trial and has
prayed that since the petitioner is more than 66 years of age, thus, his
personal appearance may kindly be exempted.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as
withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

Since, the petitioner is more than 66 years of age, his
personal appearance is exempted before the trial Court, subject to the

following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner shall be represented through his/her counsel;*
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;*
- iii) shall not dispute his identity as accused;*
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence but in the presence of his/her counsel;*
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;*
- vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.*
