The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking a direction to the respondents to bring the case bearing GD No.33 dated 21.06.2021, under Sections 307, 342, 324, 506, 295, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25,54, 59 of Arms Act , registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda to its logical conclusion by submitting a final report.

The matter was called twice today but nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner. The same was the position on the last date of hearing on 22.03.2022 when nobody had caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner. The reply has already been filed by the State and, therefore, this Court would proceed in the absence of the learned counsel for the petitioner on the basis of the pleadings and the paper-book.

The learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has stated that a status report has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Rampura Phul, District Bathinda and while referring to the affidavit he submitted that the present petition itself has become redundant in view of the fact that a SIT was constituted in the present case and it has been recommended for cancellation of the GD No.33 dated 21.06.2021 and the cancellation report will be presented before the learned Court in accordance with law. He submitted that in view of the aforesaid position nothing survives in the present petition since the prayer of the petitioner in the present petition was seeking a direction for bringing the case GD No.33 dated 21.06.2021 to its logical conclusion.

I have heard the learned counsel for the State.

The prayer in the present petition was for bringing the GD No.33 dated 21.06.2021 to its logical conclusion. As per the stand taken by the learned State counsel relying upon the affidavit filed by the State, a SIT was constituted and as per recommendation of the SIT it has been decided for cancellation of the GD No.33 dated 21.06.2021.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition, the same is therefore dismissed as having become redundant.
