1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.06.2020, in CWP-7605-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 02.06.2020 reveals that CWP-7605-2020, was disposed of by directing the Chairman, Punjab Grains Procurement Corporation Ltd., to decide legal notice dated 12.03.2020, by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case it was found that the petitioner was entitled to any monetary benefits, to release the same to him within next two months.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents refers to Annexure R/2 dated 08.02.2021, granting certain financial benefits to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of Annexure R/2 dated 08.02.2021, the petitioner does not press instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
