Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of directions to respondents no.2, 4 and 5 to sympathetically decide the representation dated 28.06.2022 (Annexure P-4), filed by the petitioner.

Grievance raised in this writ petition is that petitioner is sought to be illegally and forcefully ejected from the plot in question, which is stated to have been duly allotted to him. Prayer is for restraining the respondents from taking any action against the petitioner or demolition of construction over the plot without any notice etc.

As per the short reply by way of affidavit dated 21.11.2022 of Mr. Gurmeet Singh, BDPO, Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur, Punjab, allotment of the plot in favour of the petitioner was cancelled way-back on 30.05.2012. As the petitioner was found to be residing in his own permanent house, he was not found entitled to allotment of plot. It is further stated that petitioner has raised temporary construction over the plot in question in an

illegal manner and is an unauthorized occupant thereon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact no such notice of cancellation of allotment was ever received by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in view of the facts and circumstances, petitioner seeks to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
