The petitioner cleared her Class X examination in the year 2019. Certificate issued thereafter recorded her date of birth incorrectly and, thus, she approached her school who sent an E-mail dated 01.10.2020 to CBSE. Thereafter, representation dated 07.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) was also submitted by the petitioner accompanied by birth certificate dated 21.07.2020 but correction sought was not made. Thus, the present writ petition has been filed.

In reply filed on behalf of the respondents it has been submitted that date of birth can not be corrected on the basis of a birth certificate issued after the issuance of Class X certificate. The school has been asked to supply relevant particulars but no response has been received.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction may be issued to the CBSE to decide the pending representation dated 07.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order within a limited time frame.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the

CBSE to decide the pending representation dated 07.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) in

accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
