The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the order dated 17.05.2022 (Annexure P-2) vide which the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner has been cancelled and forfeited to the State and further non-bailable warrants have been issued against him.

While issuing notice of motion on 05.09.2022, the learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted on instructions from the petitioner that he undertakes to surrender before the learned trial Court within one week. Consequently directions were issued to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and even interim orders were also passed that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner, till the time he surrenders.

Today the learned State counsel has stated, on instructions from

ASI Balwant Singh, that till date the petitioner has not surrendered and the aforesaid period of one week has already expired and rather more than two months have expired.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.
