Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short “the Code”) seeking quashing of FIR No.207 dated 29.07.2018, registered for offences under Sections 354, 370, 370-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Section 24(1)(b) of the Emigration Act, 1983, at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Mr. Parminder Singh Kanwar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.

Considering the nature of allegations levelled in the FIR, Annexure P-1, this Court is not inclined to exercise inherent powers vested in it under Section 482 of the Code.

Petition is dismissed.
