Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0010 dated 09.02.2022, under Section 6 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012; Sections 10, 11, 9 of Children Marriage Prohibition Act, 2006 and Sections 120-B, 323, 34, 342, 376(2)(n), 377, 498-A, 506 of IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Vide order dated 02.09.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 02.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 opposed the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from PSI Sakshi, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 02.09.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
