The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4, as they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied if the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar i.e. respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 27.08.2022 (Annexure P-5), made to him by the petitioners in this regard and take appropriate action on the same.

As per averments made in the petition, both the petitioners are major. Dates of birth of both the petitioners are 18.10.2002 and 07.06.2001, respectively. Copies of Aadhar cards of both the petitioners are appended with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively. They got married on 25.08.2022 as per Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-3. Photographs of the marriage are Annexure P-4.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manipal Atwal, DAG,
Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for
the petitioners and without going into the merits of the claim raised by
the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent
No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the representation
dated 27.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same expeditiously, in
accordance with law.
