Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.126 dated 29.09.2021, under Sections 498-A, 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 14.10.2021, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.10.2021, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kamal Kishore, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 14.10.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
