The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to re-evaluate his answer sheet for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had applied for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical) in general category against advertisement issued on 13.07.2017 (Annexure P-1). He had appeared in the written examination and as per his own calculation, he had obtained 154 marks while the cut off marks in general category were 148 marks.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, while issuing notice to the respondents on 10.10.2018, had allowed the petitioner to appear provisionally in the interview and his result was ordered to be kept in a sealed cover.

Learned State counsel has produced the result of the petitioner in Court which indicates that the petitioner had obtained a total of 144 marks which include 136 marks in the written examination and 8 marks in the interview. It is also stated that the cut off marks for interview were 148 and the petitioner had obtained 136 marks in the written examination and therefore, he

was not called for the interview but was interviewed later provisionally in terms of the order of the Court. A copy of the result of the petitioner is taken on record.

Heard.

A perusal of the record would not indicate that the answer sheet of the petitioner was not evaluated in a proper manner. As the petitioner had obtained even lesser marks than the cut off marks for interview, I do not find any merit in this petition which stands dismissed.
