AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition) who are forcing the petitioner to give resignation from the post of Municipal Councillor.

The brief facts are that the petitioner is an elected Municipal Councillor of Ward No. 16, Municipal Council, Zira. He had got registered FIR No. 82, dated 20.8.2022 against unknown person. Thereafter, a complaint was made with regard to threat perception.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice on instructions from ASI-Balwinder Singh submits that the allegations levelled in the FIR are being investigated. He further submits that after considering the complaint, no threat perception was found to the petitioner. The petitioner can collect the decision of the complaint from the SHO concerned on any working day.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, the petition is dismissed.
