The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents to decide representation dated 05.07.2021 submitted to the Sub Divisional Magistrate Tauru (Annexure P-2) and to the Deputy Commissioner, Mewat at Nuh (Annexure P-3) and to the Commissioner, Faridabad (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner is poor widow lady and has no source of income and her husband had died on 21.03.2008. On account of heavy rain storm, her house was damaged and the wall as well as the roof fell down on 30.05.2022. She has already submitted a representation to the authority for financial help so as to reconstruct/repair her damaged house. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the authorities are called upon to look into the representation and to pass an appropriate order in terms of the applicable State policy.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Chauhan, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and he has no objection to the petition being disposed of.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner Mewat at Nuh to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner and to take appropriate steps in accordance with law and any applicable policy, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
