Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition is filed in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the daughter of the petitioner (Asha Rani) from the illegal custody of respondent No.4.

On 27.11.2020 notice of motion was issued, SHO, Police Station Jalalabad was directed to get the statement of the detainee recorded and also to ensure her availability through Video conferencing.

Learned State Counsel produced the statement of the detainee, the same is taken on record wherein she has stated that she is married to respondent No.4 and is blessed with a child who is two months old. She is residing happily with her husband.

Today detainee is present through Video Conferencing and is identified by ASI Balwinder Singh. Court has interacted with her and she submits that she has solemnized marriage with respondent No. 4 and is happily residing in her in-law's house.
