Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur to take necessary steps for the welfare of Tannu, minor daughter of the petitioner who is less than one year old.

The matter had come up for hearing before this Court on 07.09.2022. Learned State Counsel was instructed to complete instructions in the matter.

Today on resumed hearing, learned State Counsel, on instructions from Ms. Seema Rani, Child Protection Officer (Institutional Care) and Ms. Baljinder Kaur, Legal-cum-Probation Officer (District Child Protection Unit) has apprised that the minor child is along with her mother

and in her custody.

In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant civil writ petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
