Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, though, the amount, which the petitioner was liable to return to the respondent No. 4-Bank, has already been returned but, according to the petitioner, the amount deducted by the bank from the retiral benefits of the petitioner is over and above their entitlement keeping in view the loan received by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the bank furnish him the exact calculations mentioning the outstanding amount so as to justify their claim, which have been received by them from the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, learned

Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Naginder Singh Vashisht, Advocate, who is also present in Court, accept notice on behalf of respondent No. 4-Bank.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No. 4-bank submits that if the bank has not already supplied the calculation, the same will again be supplied to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy in case, he is aggrieved against the calculation with regard to the recovery of the amount.

Ordered accordingly.
