Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents to release the retiral benefits etc. to the petitioner along with interest till its realization, as the petitioner retired from the post of WPO-II in Public Health Engineering Division No.1, Jind, on 31.07.2021.

2. *Qua* his grievance, petitioner has already submitted representation dated 12.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) but the same has not been adverted till date. Hence the petition.

3. On advance service, learned state counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending representation dated 12.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation, as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 12.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within 60 days from today.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
