This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3 to 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and society members are aggrieved of the outsiders, who regularly enters in the society and organize their functions without any permission and create nuisance; that on one day, they clicked the photographs of the house of the petitioner and on asking, the outsiders ran away from the spot and that qua the said issue, the petitioner has sent a representation to respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, but till date no action has been taken on the same.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and have also gone through the paper-book.

The complaint in question is dated 30.08.2022, the postal receipt vide which the representation was sent to respondent No.2, is also of same

date and the date of filing of the present petition is 01.09.2022, which shows that the petitioner without waiting for the action being taken by the office of respondent No.2, rushed to this Court by way of filing the present petition. The perusal of the paper-book would itself reveals that earlier also, the petitioner has approached this Court vide CRWP-2111-2022, in which after considering the grievance of the petitioner, appropriated directions were issued by this Court vide order dated 09.03.2022.

In view of the above, this Court is of the view that the petitioner is in the habit of filing false and frivolous petitions and thus, he is wasting the time of this Court without waiting for the procedure being adopted by the Office of the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, on his representation dated 30.08.2022.

The petition is dismissed with a cost of Rs. 50,000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority, Jalandhar.
