Prayer in this writ petition is for directing the respondents to ensure removal of illegal encroachment carried out by three persons, namely Dilawar, Rajbir and Kartar, who are held to be illegally encroaching upon land in question and for execution of order dated 11.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Bhiwani in application filed under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (as applicable to the State of Haryana) by Nafe Singh, who is stated to be grand-father of the present petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though

Appeal No.52-E of 2021 has been filed by Dilawar s/o Kapoor Singh and

Appeal No.50-E of 2021 has been filed by Kartar s/o Chander Bhan, there is no interim order in their favour, however still authorities concerned are not taking any action for removal of illegal encroachment.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional A.G., Haryana, to whom advance copy of paper book has been supplied, accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties but without expressing any opinion on merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority/respondent No.3 to decide pending appeals as mentioned above expeditiously and definitely within a period of three months from date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and after affording opportunity of hearing to all concerned/affected parties. Necessary action be taken by the respondents in accordance with law.
