On 06.09.2022, the following order was passed:-

“CRM-32917-2022

Application is allowed, as prayed for.

CRM-M-40470-2022

Apprehending his arrest in FIR No.282 dated 19.08.2022, registered under Sections 323, 452, 506 & 34 of the IPC at Police Station Kasola, District Rewari, Haryana, petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter-alia* contends that no offence under Section 452 IPC shall be made out and the other offences for which the petitioner has been booked are bailable.

Notice of motion for 13.12.2022.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl.AG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and seeks time to get instructions.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, Mr. Ambavta, on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

3. Apart from this, keeping in view that apart from Section 452 IPC, all the offences for which the petitioner has been booked are bailable.

4. In view of the above, the interim order dated 06.09.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands disposed off.
