Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing Clause 18 of order dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P-7), whereby the appointment of the petitioner on the post of Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant (VLDA) under BC-B category, has been withheld and no reasons are coming forth.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted representations dated 25.04.2022 and 29.04.2022 (Annexures P-8 & P-9 respectively), but the same have not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by the competent authority, either way, on the pending representations of the petitioner by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representations, as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the pending representations dated 25.04.2022 and 29.04.2022 (Annexures P-8 & P-9 respectively) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, giving reasons thereof, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible but in any case not later than 30 days.

8. Disposed of accordingly.

9. Till the decision on the pending representations is taken, one post of VLDA, in the category petitioner had applied in, shall be kept vacant.
