The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate the matter thoroughly in the representation dated 27.06.2022 and 12.07.2022 (Annexure P-2 and Annexure P-3) whereby the petitioner prays for removing the tubewell of the private respondents who has illegally installed the same and a further prayer to issue direction to the private respondents not to use the tubewell during the pendency of the present civil writ petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly concedes that the dispute in relation to installation of the tubewell is with the private party.

In view of the above, the efficacious remedy available in law would be by means of approaching the competent Civil Court if not approached already. He thus seeks permission to withdraw the present

petition so as to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
