**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.148 dated 09.06.2020 registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat, under Sections 406/420/506/34 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 02.12.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panipat, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Jagdish, Deepak and Om Parkash as

well as of complainant Deepak have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Deepak in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panipat, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.148 dated 09.06.2020 registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat, under Sections 406/420/506/34 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
