In compliance of order dated 05.09.2022 learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Narwana, District Jind dated 29.10.2022 on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, disclosing that no struggling marks were observed on the spot and there is no indication of strangulation on the deceased and it could be a case of hanging.

Learned State counsel further submits that further investigation is going on and jurisdictional police authorities have already been directed to take care of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedy as permissible under law.

Dismissed with aforesaid liberty.
