Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the present case, the petitioners belong to Mewat Cadre and hence, they have preferential right of occupying the promotional post of ESHM but, the respondents are transferring ESHM from the “rest of the Haryana Cadre”, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners as the petitioners are not being given promotions, which are being given to the employees of outside cadre which act of the respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P/6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in their representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P/6) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
